Discuss and Consider the ERU Study presentation from Wilson & Co. Charles Loughman and Doug Goetz gave a presentation about Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) method. Charles explained the process and that (ERU) method) is used by more than 80 percent of all stormwater utilities. It bills an amount proportional to the impervious area on a parcel, regardless of the parcel's total area. It is therefore based on the effect of a typical single family residential (SFR) home's impervious area footprint. After discussion and questions with the Stormwater Board from the previous meeting the group from Wilson & Co. meeting provide a scope and fee for the service for the city to have this ERU study preformed the recommended City staff move forward with the presentation of the study by Wilson & Co for Discussion and Consideration.
