

**MINUTES OF THE STORM WATER MANAGEMENT ADVISORY BOARD
THE CITY OF PARK CITY, KANSAS
COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1941 E. 61st STREET NORTH
June 25, 2020**

ROLL CALL

The following were present: Board Members Terry Ford, Kyle Lang, Richard Stadtherr, and Gary Aldrich.

Also in attendance were Marlo Rugg, Public Works Director Eric Miner, and Assistant Public Works Director Zach Day.

Board Member Gary Aldrich called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

APPROVAL OF THE MAY 28, 2020 MINUTES

Board Member Kyle Lang moved to approve the minutes of May 28, 2020. Board Member Richard Stadtherr seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

PUBLIC FORUM

STAFF REPORTS

Assistant Public Works Director Zach Day gave a brief update on the maintenance of the City's ditches. He stated the work is being concentrated on the ditches between Denver and Evanston. He stated rip rap was placed in the ditches on west and east Parkview Street.

NEW BUSINESS

Assistant Public Works Director Zach Day stated staff continues to clean and maintain the ditches with rock and fill in with dirt. He stated staff continues to spray and mow in the areas where they can. He stated some of the equipment has suffered damage. Mr. Day stated staff is making do with what equipment they have. He stated the bigger projects will require more money to clean and maintain. Board Member Gary Aldrich asked what fund the cost of the rip rap is expensed out of. Mr. Day stated the Streets Department is paying for that material. Mr. Day stated the areas near Ashford and Jardine are areas the Board need to look at maintaining.

Board Member Kyle Lang stated his neighbors ditch is back filling. Public Works Director Eric Miner stated to call the City offices to report the issue.

Board Member Richard Stadtherr stated there is a dam north of 45th Street on Hydraulic Street that has caused sediment to back up into the upstream retention ponds. He asked if the accumulating sediment caused a problem for the retention ponds and would it be necessary in the future to dredge the sediment. Mr. Day stated he would need to look at the area to assess the information and come up with a solution.

Board Member Terry Ford moved to adjourn at 6:43 pm. Board Member Richard Stadtherr seconded the motion. Motion carried. 3-0.
