Motion passed 8-0.

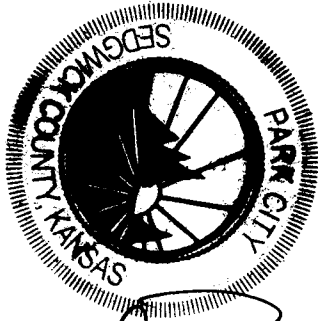
2. FEE STRUCTURE
