The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Lehnerr at 6:00 pm.

1. 2023 BUDGET WORK SESSION

Finance Director Dee Anne Grunder stated she had the figures to implement a 3.8% COLA on July 31, 2022. She stated that amount is \$60,729.00. Ms. Grunder stated the two notices of hearing for the Land Bank and the Revenue Neutral Rate and Budget hearing.

A discussion ensued on employee pay increases for 2022 and 2023. Council agreed on a 3.8% COLA increase starting on July 31, 2022 and will budget for a 5% COLA increase on January 1, 2023.

Council Member Ben Saucedo moved to approve the notice of hearing to exceed the revenue neutral rate as presented.

Council Member George Glover seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Ben Saucedo moved to approve the notice of budget hearing as presented.

Council Member Tom Jones seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

2. DISCUSSION ONLY ON UPCOMING PROLAMATION

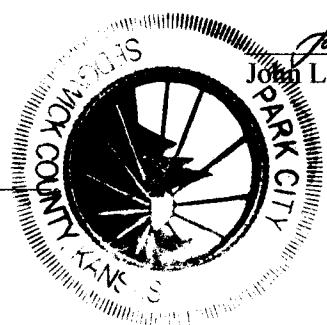
Mayor John Lehnerr informed Council on an upcoming proclamation that will be presented on August 13, 2022.
